Idea 1: Entry into Jerusalem		Design a palm leaf. What words would you be shouting if you saw Jesus arriving into Jerusalem? Write the words on your leaf.	Write a newspaper account of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem. What would your headline be? What would the disciples be saying? What would the Roman Empire be saying/thinking? What would the crowd be saying?
Idea 2: The Last Supper	If you were inviting people to a meal, who would your 12 people be? What food would you eat? Design a menu for the occasion. What act of service will you do at the meal to show your love for your guests?		
Idea 3: Easter themes: Betrayal, loneliness, forgiveness, love, new life	Design a symbol that represents one of these themes. Write a poem on one of the themes.

Imagine you are one of the disciples sending a post card home to your parent.</p> <p>Write a post card to describe the events of the day and how it has made you feel.</p> <p>Choose one of the events.</p> <p>Draw the occasion. Give your picture a title. What title would you give the event?</p>	<p>Diary entry</p> <p>Imagine you are one of the disciples. Choose one the events. Write a diary entry to describe the events of the day and how it made you feel. What questions are you left thinking about?</p>
<p>Idea 5: Easter day</p>	<p>Create an Easter garden using a range of collage/ materials of your choice.</p> <p>You can make this garden inside a shoe box/lunch box container/tinfoil container etc</p> <p>Consider what needs to be in your garden:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tomb Strips of cloth Flowers The risen Christ Women who anointed the body What else might you include? 		
<p>Idea 6: Jesus loved the world so much that he was prepared to die for the whole of humanity.</p>	<p>Design a card to send to someone to remind them of how much you love them.</p> <p>What would you put on your card to show someone that you loved them?</p> <p>What would you write in the card?</p> <p>What message could you write that would let them know that you loved them and were thinking about them?</p> <p>Do you want to thank them for something they have done for you?</p>
