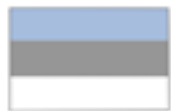
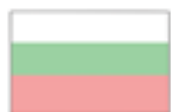

Thursday 11th November 2024

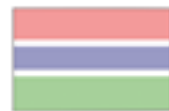
School Hall 3.30pm - 4.30pm

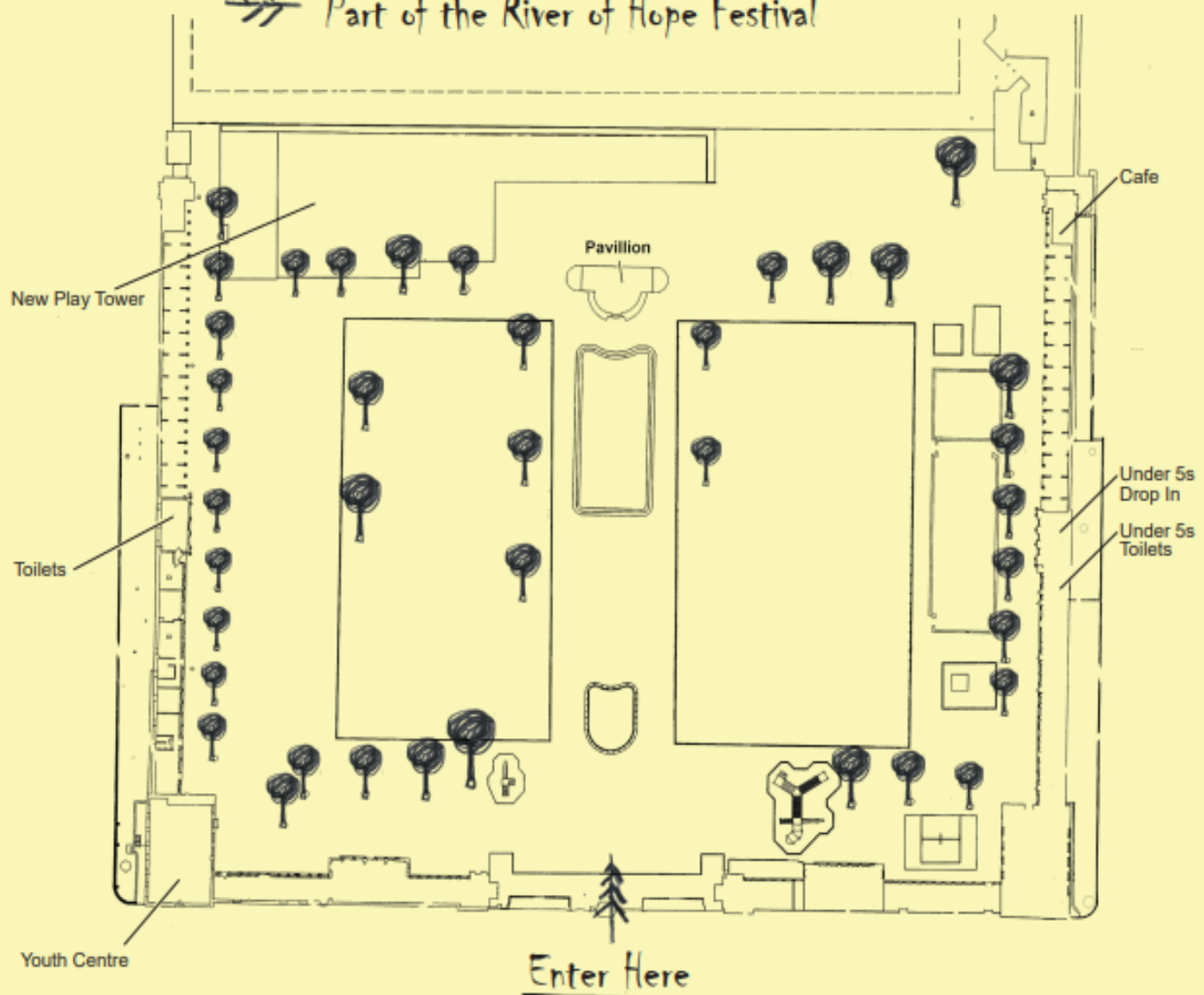
